) **REGARDING COMPLIANCE WITH THE**  
) **COURT'S ORDER DATED JUNE 23, 2025**

1 Defendants respectfully submit this Status Report pursuant to the Case Management Conference,  
2 the Court's Minute Entry dated July 2, 2025 (Dkts. 56 & 60), and the Court's Order dated July 11, 2025  
3 (Dkt. 67). This Report provides an update regarding Defendant EPA's status of compliance with the  
4 Court's Preliminary Injunction Order dated June 23, 2025 (Dkts. 54 & 55).

5 EPA represents that on July 14, 2025 it completed reinstatement of the identified grants that were  
6 not naturally expired pursuant to their terms.

7 On July 11, 2025, Defendants shared with Plaintiffs' counsel a spreadsheet listing the 25 grants  
8 identified to be reinstated, which includes for each grant award: (1) the grant identifier information, (2)  
9 the project costs and cumulative award amount, (3) the project title, and (4) the grantee's name and  
10 information.

11 EPA notes that one of the identified grants, titled "Development of a Data-Driven Model for  
12 Assessing Benefits and Risks of the pgSIT Approach for Ae. Aegypti Eradication in Hawaii" (No.  
13 84020401), was not reinstated because its expired pursuant to its terms on June 30, 2025. The grant is in  
14 a close-out process, and EPA awaits a final report from the recipient requesting reimbursement for any  
15 additional project expenses incurred. If the recipient's final report requests reimbursement, EPA will pay  
16 the recipient out of the remaining \$95,406 balance on the \$749,887.00 grant.
